

TREND: State Legislators are Largely Rejecting State Preemption Bills that Prohibit Local Governments from Adopting Pit Bull Laws

12 Year Trend: January 2012 to December 31, 2023

In 2012, a new wave of state preemption bills barring cities and counties from enacting breedspecific laws began being pushed by Utah-based fighting dog advocates, Best Friends Animal Society, and dog breeder interest groups.

Since January 2012, state legislators have rejected 85% (56) of these preemption bills. Over the last 5 years, Jan. 2019 to Dec. 2023, the <u>rejection rate increased to 92%</u>.

Jurisdictions can enact and enforce breed-specific laws, as long as a city or county maintains a "reasonable process for exempting any dog from breed-based regulations or a breed ban if the dog passes the American Kennel Club Canine Good Citizen test" or its equivalent.
