


14 Year U.S. Dog Bite Fatality Chart - 2005 to 2018

During this 14-year period, 471 Americans suffered death due to dog bite injury.

[†] This category includes: Italian, English, South African and Neapolitan mastiffs, bullmastiffs and mastiff-mixes. This category excludes: cane corsos, presa canarios and Dogo argentinos. [‡] 7 dog breeds contributed from 9 to 4 deaths, 8 breeds contributed from 3 to 2 deaths, and 20 breeds contributed to 1 death. 9.3% of all fatal attacks involve multiple breeds, thus the total number of deaths attributed to each breed will always exceed the actual number of deaths.
