




I am a spayed blue & white pit bull \ mix. My friends at the shelter think I am about 3 years old. I came to the shelter on 8/18/2014.

WHEN I ARRIVED ON-SCNE, I WAS MET BY CHP, S/O TASK FORCE, AND CLOVRDALE PD WHO WERE SERVING A WARRANT ON THE PROPERTY.

A DETECTIVE SAID THERE WERE 9 DOGS ON THE PROPERTY IN DEPLORABLE CONDITIONS, 4 PITBULLS AND 5 CHIHUAHUAS IN A SHED.

I FIRST VIEWED THE CHIHUAHUAS THAT WERE LOCATED IN THE SHED. THE SHED WAS CONSTRUCTED OF WOOD, BUT THE DOOR WAS SEALED OFF FROM ENTERING THE BUILING BY CHICKEN WIRE. I COULD SEE NO FOOD OR WATER. THERE WAS A MATTRESS THAT ALL THE DOGS WERE ON, WHICH WAS COMPLETLY COVERED IN URINE AND FECES. THE SMELL FECES, URINE AND AMMONIA WAS OVERWHELMING.

THE DETECTIVE THEN SHOWED ME THE 4 PITBULLS. THE DOGS WERE LOCATED IN THE BACKYARD OF THE REAR UNIT OF THE MAIN HOUSE. NO FOOD OR WATER WAS SEEN. THE BACKYARD WAS COMPLETELY COVERED IN GARBAGE, FECES AND DEBRIS.

I MET WITH THE DOG OWNER WHO DID NOT SPEAK ANY ENGLISH. A MAN TRANSLATED FOR ME. I AD VISED THE DOG OWNER THAT THE DOGS WERE IN TERRIBLE CONDITIONS. SHE SAID SHE KEEPS THE CHIHUAHUAS IN THE SHED BECAUSE OF WILD ANIMALS IN THEE AREA. SHE STATED THAT SHE KNEW THE CONDITIONS WERE BAD AND SHE HAD NO EXCUSE. SHE STATED THAT HER 17 YEAR OLD SON OWNS THE 4 PITBULLS. I ADVISED HER THAT HE IS A MINOR AND ARE CONSIDERED HER PROPERTY. EXPLAINED THE RELINQUISHMENT FORM. AGREED TO RELINQUISH ALL 9 DOGS TO THE COUNTY AND SIGNED PAPERWORK. I GAVE HER A COPY AND ADVISED HER IF SHE CHANGES HER MIND SHE MAY CONTACT OUR DEPARTMENT. -513
