			I wanted to let you know of a situation that I thought was concerning. I walked up to dispatch and Shirley, Megan and two volunteers were sitting on the floor at the opening to dispatch with the dog Jolene sitting in the middle of the group. The volunteers were letting her lick their faces. As I've noted in Jolene's file, she has only shown me aggression in her kennel. Jolene watched me the entire time, her eyes began to dilate, all the while, everyone on the floor continued to pet her and have their faces very close to Jolene's. I told them to be careful because she, Jolene, doesn't like me and I didn't want anyone to get hurt. I then heard comments like, "oh she will never hurt anyone", "they can be much different out of the kennel", blowing off my warning.
			Any dog closely surrounded by four people in a small unfamiliar busy area can become nervous, fearful, and potentially bite to get out of the situation. Jolene has already shown aggression numerous times to me and others. Jolene also has a severe injury causing pain, Jolene could have easily bit because of the pain.
			The situation staff put volunteers and the dog in was very irresponsible.
