NARRATIVE #1

On 01-23-2013, at approximately 1818, received a call from a concerned citizen about a dog being loose and also another dog not able to get water and shelter. I arrived along with Capt. Sayer and Cpl. Ankerich at approximately 1850 and saw that a black dog coming from the porch area that didn't have a leash. I knocked on the door several times and got no answer. We then went to the back yard area to see if we could locate the other dog. I saw with the aid of the flashlight another dog that appeared to have it's tether hooked on debris and vegetation that prevented it from going to it's dog house and also from getting water. The local temperature in the area at night had been reaching below freezing.

I was able to free the dog as it went on to drink water. While removing other debris the owner of the residence came outside after being notified by a neighbor that we were outside. Capt. Sayer told me as I came to the front of the house, that the owner was going inside to get identification and also that he had taken a couple of pictures of the dogs.

The owner whom was identified as Sandra Bowers Adams said that she was in the back area of the house and didn't hear me knocking and also she had let the dog outside unsupervised approximately a half hour ago so the dog could use the bathroom while she was inside. Adams was explained the city ordinance of the leash law and also how we had untangled the other dog from the debris in the back yard*. Adams was issued a city citation #C32723 for violation of the leash law along with Capt. Sayer saying that he had seen the dog wandering in the street unsupervised on several occasions. He just didn't know that the dog belonged to her.

Adams received assigned court date of 03-11-2013 and copy of the citation.

SUPPLEMENT #2

On Wednesday January 23, 2013 at approximately 1820 this officer arrived at South Forest Avenue due to a report of a dog at large and a second dog being tangled up and unable to get to its food and water.

Upon arrival this officer observed Cpl. Starks was knocking on the front door and Cpl. Ankerich standing to the side of her patrol vehicle in the driveway. This officer also observed a black dog which resembled a black Labrador retriever which was free and walking around within the yard. This officer took a photo of the dog as Cpl. Starks freed the tangled up dog. Sandra Adams come up to the officer and asked if she could help us. This officer explained to her that we had received a call in reference to her dog roaming around and another dog not being able to get to its water.

Ms. Adams asked if we respond to all calls like this and this officer advised yes, and that this officer had written search warrants to be able to retrieve the neglected dogs. Ms. Adams then requested to know who called and she was advised that this officer did not know. But were received a call and witnessed was reported.

Ms. Adams stated that she had just let the black dog out and that he had only been out thirty minutes and he never left the yard. This officer advised her that this officer had seen her dog in the road as well as in the area but did not know it was her dog. Cpl. Starks issued a citation and we left.

ON MAY 04, 2013 THIS OFFICER WAS DISPATCHED BY COMMUNICATION OFFICER CHRISTOPHER MILFORD TO TWO RESIDENCES, [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] SOUTH FOREST AVENUE REGARDING SOME DOGS RUNNING LOOSE.

UPON ARRIVING THIS OFFICER MET WITH [REDACTED] AT [REDACTED] SOUTH FOREST AVENUE. [REDACTED] INFORMED THIS OFFICER THAT THE NEIGHBORS, THE ADAMS FAMILY AT [REDACTED] SOUTH FOREST AVENUE, KEEPS SEVERAL DOGS AND THAT TWO OF THEM HAVE GOTTEN OUT OF THEIR FENCED AREA TODAY AND HAVE BEEN OVER IN HER YARD CAUSING TROUBLE. [REDACTED] ALSO ADVISED THAT THERE WAS ALSO A DOG IN THEIR BACK YARD THAT HAS TANGLED ITSELF UP ON ITS RUNNER AND DOES NOT HAVE ANY FOOD OR WATER. THE HOUSE AT [REDACTED] SOUTH FOREST AVENUE IS VACANT. [REDACTED] OWNS THE PROPERTY.

CPL. ED STARKS JOINED THIS OFFICER AND UPON CHECKING WE FOUND THAT THERE WAS A DOG (PIT BULL MIX) THAT WAS ON A RUNNER AND WAS TANGLED UP AND DID NOT HAVE ANY FOOD OR WATER. WE ALSO FOUND TWO DOGS (PIT BULL MIX) RUNNING AT LARGE WITHOUT AND LEASH, COLLAR OR TAGS. WE ALSO OBSERVED TWO OTHER DOGS THAT ALSO APPEARED TO BE PIT BULL MIX IN A FENCED AREA.

UPON KNOCKING AT THE FRONT DOOR OF THE RESIDENCE WE WERE GREATED BY [REDACTED] WHO ADVISED THAT THE DOGS WERE HERS AND THAT SHE WAS SORRY, THAT SHE WILL PUT THEM UP AND FIX IT WHERE THEY CAN'T GET OUT OF THE FENCE ANYMORE.

[REDACTED] TOOK THE TWO DOGS INSIDE AND A FEW MOMENTS LATER HER MOTHER, MS. SANDRA ADAMS CAME OUT AND BEGAN TELLING US THAT THE DOGS WERE NOT REALLY THEIRS, BUT BELONGED TO [REDACTED] WHO WAS A FRIEND OF [REDACTED]

WHEN [REDACTED] RETURNED TO THE FRONT PORCH WITH HER MOTHER IT WAS LEARNED THAT THEY HAVE NOT HAD ANY CONTACT WITH [REDACTED] FOR A FEW WEEKS NOW AND [REDACTED] STLL ADVISED THAT THE DOGS WERE REALLY HERS AND [REDACTED] DOGS TOGETHER.

ONCE THE DOGS HAD BEEN TAKEN CARE OF, INCLUDING THE ONE TANGLED UP, THIS OFFICER ADVISED [REDACTED] AND MS. SANDRA ADAMS OF THE LEASH LAWS AND WARNED THEM THAT SHOULD THIS NEGLECT CONTINUE THEY WERE SUBJECT TO BE CHARGED. DURING OUR VISIT ON THIS CALL THE DOGS WERE NOT SEEN OFF THE OFF THE ADAM'S PROPERTY BY US.

THEY BOTH ADVISED THAT THEY UNDERSTOOD AND WOULD TAKE CARE OF THE DOGS.

On 03/30/2015 at around 1316 Alethia Beattie dispatched I, Officer Keith Cheek to the police department in reference to a report. When I arrived, the complainant said on 03/28/15 at around 1700 hours while she was walking her dog's on Highland Avenue, one of her dog's was attacked by another dog that was at large.

SUPPLEMENT #2

said on 03/28/15 at around 1700 hours she was walking her dog's on Highland Avenue. said as she cut through a residence yard a white pit bull came charging at her dog's from 64 Highland Avenue. said she saw Sandra Adams holding the dog on a leash, but it broke loose from her and came after her dogs.

said as the pit was charging at her dog's, her dog's reacted and pulled her causing to fall to the ground. said the pit then bit one of her dog's on the leg and tried to bite her dog's neck. said then came running out and pulled her dog off of her dog and took it back to 64 Highland Avenue. I asked if she was injured during the incident and she said no.

SUPPLEMENT #3

On 04/01/2015 at around 1330 hours I went to 64 Highland Avenue to follow up on this report. When I arrived, I spoke with Sandra Adams. She said on the day of the incident she was walking her daughter's two dogs in her yard. Adams said as she was walking them, the leashes got crossed up and she dropped one of them. Adams said at about the same time was walking her dogs up Highland Avenue, her dog ran out to the street and got close to dogs but did not fight with them. Adams said her daughter got to her dog quickly and brought it back to her residence.

Adams said she asked if she was ok and she said she was. I advised Adams that she needed to keep control of her dog's at all time's and she said she understood. No further action was taken at this time.

On December 25, 2015 This officer was dispatched by Communication Officer Alethela Beattie to Investigate an animal complaint at the indicated location. Upon arriving this officer met with the two victims and they explained that while they were out running / jogging that a white pit bulldog had charged at them and and was acting vicious. They both advised that this pit bulldog did not have any collar on and there was not any leash attached to it.

SUPPLEMENT #2

Dog of concern: The dog appears to be a pit bulldog, white in color, male, rather large in size, wearing no collar. Resides at #64 Highland Avenue with Ms. Sandra Adams.

On December 25, 2015 this officer had been dispatched to Highland Avenue to talk with a person about some type of dog complaint. Upon arriving this officer met with both of the listed victims, and who were out in the driveway next to the roadway. This address is the residence of

While talking with both and this officer learned that a few minutes earlier they had been running / jogging along the small residential street of Highland Avenue. When they were in front of Highland Avenue a large, white pit bulldog came charging at them and had to push out of the way to keep her from being attacked. Both and advised that they were together, but for some reason the pit bulldog came charging directly at her and almost got her, but after being diverted the pit bulldog made contact with leg, but did not actually get to bite him before he was run off.

and advised that they and the neighborhood have had problems with this dog before running loose in the area and they advised that the dog lives at #64 Highland Avenue. They also both advised that they feel that the dog is too aggressive toward people. and advised that the dog was actually out in the front yard with its' owner before it charged them. They provided a description of this owner and this officer was familiar with who they were talking about.

This officer then left and went to #64 Highland and as this officer arrived Ms. Sandra Adams approached me in the driveway advising how sorry she was and that the dog just ran out the door before she could grab him. She advised that the dog lives in the house Ms. Adams also advised that the dog was not her dog, that it belonged to her daughter, who is not living at this location.

This officer explained to Ms. Adams that she has had a lot of contact with this law enforcement agency about dogs to know that the dogs must be maintained in a fenced area or a confined area and when not, they have to have a collar with tags and be controled with a dog leash. Ms. Adams admitted that she did know, but again advised that the dog ran out the door before she could grab him.

This officer issued Ms. Adams a citation, #C30594, charging her with allowing a dog to run at large which is a violation of Hartwell City Ordinance #6-63 (#6-71) and issued her a court date of March 28, 2015.

This officer then returned to residence where this officer talked with and again and briefed them on the enforcement action taken and the court date that was issued. This officer also advised them that this report would be completed and that a copy would be available for them should they desire one.

On December 25, 2015 this officer was at the residence of [REDACTED] talking with him and his friend, [REDACTED] about a dog that had acted aggressive toward them. This officer had issued the owner (Ms. Sandra Adams) a citation for allowing the dog to run loose in the neighborhood.

During this conversation with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both expressed a great concern about this white pit bulldog because every time it gets loose and runs the neighborhood it will pick at least someone out and act aggressive toward them. Both advised that there are several neighbors who have called in their concerns about this dog.

This officer advised [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] of the procedure to attempt having the dog declared aggressive and advised them that I would check with this agency's records for information.

As indicated above with the references, during 2013, 2014 and 2015 there have been six reports written including this one addressing Ms. Sandra Adams. Ms. Sandra Adams has been issued three warnings and three citations. The last three reports listed above appear to deal with this white pit bulldog. This officer checked only under Ms. Sandra Adams and did not check under [REDACTED] who is her daughter. Under the most recent ordinances of 6-71 and 6-75 it appears that this white pit bulldog can be declared a nuisance if this is the same white pit bulldog in previous incidents. The Adams' residence has a history of keeping dogs, mostly pit bulldogs and white dogs seem to be a favorite.

This officer sent an Email to the attention of the clerk of court about this matter.
